




Making it easier to move around... Jurong Region Line (JRL)



JRL Stations in Yuhua -JE5 Jurong East








Making it easier to move around... Jurong East Integrated Transport Hub














Sustainability Projects

LED

- 1st Town Council to adopt LED and have achieved significant energy savings since 2010
- Replacement of all LED lights with more energy efficient LED lights in 2019





Solar Leasing Project

- HDB has installed solar panels in Jurong Central to harness solar energy
- A total of <u>40 blocks</u> of HDB flats have been installed with solar panels



Recycling Project

Cash for Trash Programme

- Started in November 2007.
- Reducing, reusing and recycling
- Cash and Trash stations are placed at high human traffic areas
- Collected recyclables such as newspapers, aluminium cans, old clothes, plastic and glass bottles.

Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP)

- The NRP was introduced in Aug 2007 focuses on block and precinct improvements.
- 91% of the eligible precincts (about 8,218 units) have completed Interim Upgrading Programme or NRP











Renewing Our Homes Home Improvement Programme (HIP)


- HIP takes care of internal refurbishment of the HDB flat.
- 100 % of the eligible flats have either been completed or on-going.
- Enhancement for Active Seniors (EASE) was also introduced to make home more elderly friendly






Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Remaking Our Heartland (ROH)

Blks 492 to 498 Jurong West St 41



In October 2016, Block 493 Jurong West Street 41 Wet Market & Coffee shop was burnt overnight.

51 stall holders lost their means to carry on their business.









A temporary market was built in 6 weeks within the vicinity of Block 493.





HDB had started building a 2-storey commercial block situated on the site of the burnt down market in August 2017.

This 2-storey block – known as **Jurong Central Plaza** comprises a market and an eating house on the 1st storey and social communal facility and active ageing space on the 2nd storey is opened in January 2019

Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Lift Upgrading Programme (LUP)

- LUP provides direct lift access to all the floors and improves mobility of the elderlies and less mobile residents.
- 100 % of the blocks eligible for LUP have been completed.





Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Lift Enhancement Programme (LEP)

- Modernise existing HDB lifts to enhance their reliability and performance
- Eligible lifts 18 years and younger (as on 1 April 2017)
- The enhancement features include protective devices to prevent unintended movement and over speeding of the lifts and light curtain sensors for lift doors
- The work will be carried out over a span of 8 years and scheduled to complete by 2027
