




Making it easier to move around... Overall Rail Network

Making it easier to move around... Jurong East Integrated Transport Hub


The new Integrated Transport Hub at Jurong East is located at the existing site of Jurong East Bus Interchange.

It would form part of an integrated commercial and transport development surrounding Jurong East MRT Station.












Expansion of Cycling Network

Sustainability Projects

LED

- 1st Town Council to adopt this innovation, we have achieved significant energy savings from this project since 2010.
- In 2019, we have replaced the former LED lights with more energy efficient LED lights.





Solar Leasing Project

- HDB has installed solar panels in Jurong Spring to harness solar energy
- A total of <u>30 blocks</u> of HDB flats have been installed with solar panels



Recycling Project

Cash for Trash Programme

- Started in November 2007.
- Reducing, reusing and recycling
- Cash and Trash stations are placed at high human traffic areas

Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP)

- The NRP was introduced in Aug 2007 and it focuses on block and precinct improvements.
- 93% of the eligible precincts (about 7,971 units) have completed Interim Upgrading Programme or NRP

Renewing Our Homes Home Improvement Programme (HIP)

- HIP takes care of internal refurbishment of the HDB flat.
- 100 % of the eligible flats have either been completed or on-going.
- Enhancement for Active Seniors (EASE) was also introduced to make home more elderly friendly





Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Lift Upgrading Programme (LUP)

- •LUP provides direct lift access to all the floors and improves mobility of the elderly and less mobile residents.
- •100 % of the blocks eligible for LUP have been completed.



Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Lift Enhancement Programme (LEP)

- Enhancement of existing HDB lifts to improve their reliability and performance
- Eligible lifts 18 years and younger (as on 1 April 2017)
- The enhancement features include protective devices to prevent unintended movement and over speeding of the lifts and light curtain sensors for lift doors
- The work will be carried out over a span of 8 years and scheduled to complete by 2027







Taking care of what we have ...

- Repairs and Redecorations (R&R)
- Re-roofing work
- •Replacement of water pipes
- Replacement of booster pumps
- Replacement of refuse chute flushing system

A Better Home for All

- Since 2015, Jurong-Clementi Town Council has spent \$2.1m on various Town Improvement projects to improve the overall living environment
- We have build
 - Covered linkways
 - Drop-off points
 - Sheltered ramps
 - Block & directional signs
 - Digital Noticeboards
 - Recreational and exercise facilities such as hard courts, jogging tracks, playgrounds, multi-generation fitness corners & games courts
 - Community gardens
 - Residents' corners
- Over the next 5 years, another \$2.5m to be spent to provide more improvement works





A Better Home for All Urban farming & Community Gardens

Several of the RCs have implemented successfully the community gardening programmes in their zones. They tap onto the retirees and those who enjoy gardening. Today, in Jurong Spring, we have **10 community gardens**.
