

JRL Stations in Yuhua -JE5 Jurong East








Making it easier to move around... Jurong East Integrated Transport Hub


The new Integrated Transport Hub at Jurong East is located at the existing site of Jurong East Bus Interchange.

JRL Stations in Bukit Batok East/ Yuhua –JE4 Toh Guan









JRL Stations in Bukit Batok/ Yuhua



Sustainability Projects

LED

- 1st Town Council to adopt this innovation, we have achieved significant energy savings from this project since 2010.
- In 2019, we have replaced the former LED lights with more energy efficient LED lights.
- The corridor lights are installed with timers and the LED lights at the staircases are fitted with motion sensors.





Solar Leasing Project

- HDB has installed solar panels in Taman Jurong to harness solar energy
- A total of <u>27 blocks</u> of HDB flats have been installed with solar panels



Recycling Project

Cash for Trash Programme

- Started in November 2007.
- Reducing, reusing and recycling
- Cash and Trash stations are placed at high human traffic areas
- Collected recyclables such as newspapers, aluminium cans, old clothes, plastic and glass bottles.



Rejuvenating our Neighbourhood Lift Enhancement Programme (LEP)

- Modernise existing HDB lifts to enhance their reliability and performance
- Eligible lifts 18 years and younger (as on 1 April 2017)
- The enhancement features include protective devices to prevent unintended movement and over speeding of the lifts and light curtain sensors for lift doors
- The work will be carried out over a span of 8 years and scheduled to complete by 2027







Taking care of what we have ...

Since 2015, Jurong-Clementi Town Council has spent \$5.6M for:

- Repairs and Redecorations (R&R)
- Re-roofing work
- Replacement of water pipes
- Replacement of booster pumps
- Replacement of refuse chute flushing system
- Replacement of water tanks lining

Completed R&R

- •Blocks 177 to 184
- Blocks 337A/D, 338A/B, 339A/D
- •Block 63 to 66

Another \$14.7M will be spent in the next 5 years

Upcoming R&R

- •Blocks 111 to 122
- Blocks 345 to 355
- •Blocks 321 to 336
- Blocks 357 to 369





A Better Home for All

- Since 2015, Jurong-Clementi Town Council has spent \$3.4m on various Town Improvement projects to improve the overall living environment
- We have built
 - Covered linkways
 - Drop-off points
 - Sheltered ramps
 - Block & directional signs
 - Digital Noticeboards
 - Recreational and exercise facilities such as basketball court, hard courts, jogging tracks, playgrounds, multi-generation fitness corners, games courts & futsal courts
 - Community hall & Plaza
 - Residents' & Study corners
 - BBQ pit & pavilion
 - Sheltered bicycle shed
 - Community gardens
- Over the next 5 years , another \$2.9m to be spent to provide more improvement works





A Better Home for All Community & Allotment Gardens

- Residents' Committees (RCs) manage 9 community gardens and some have started Allotment Gardening Scheme that allows residents to lease gardening plots for their own planting.
- More allotment gardens will be rolled out to residents to hone their skills and grow their own greens.
